Navigating the USDA GAP Workshop Audit

North Carolina State University and North Carolina Cooperative Extension are partnering with the Center for Environmental Farming Systems/*North Carolina Growing Together Project* (CEFS/NCGT), Carolina Farm Stewardship Association (CFSA) and other partners to deliver workshops across the state with the aim of providing farmers with the tools to reduce food safety risks and meet market requirements.
