Safe Sitter is a class that will teach youth how to be a better babysitter. The program is a medically accurate program that teaches youth ages 11 - 14 how to handle emergencies when caring for younger children. During the class, students get hands-on practice in basic lifesaving techniques so they are prepared to act in a crisis. To successfully complete the program, students must pass a rigorous practical and written test to show that they have mastered the key concepts and have the skills necessary to handle an emergency.
